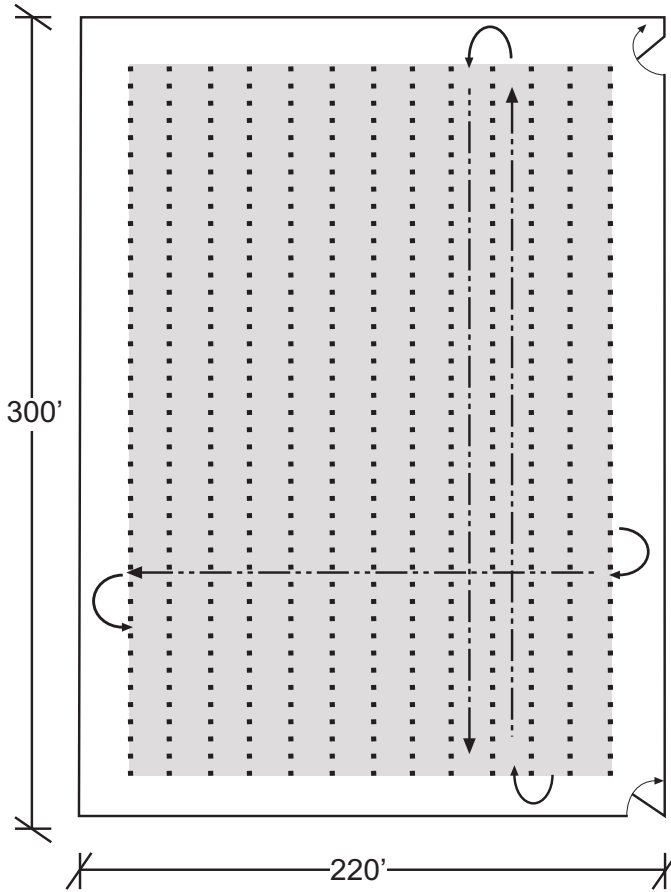


uphill section



12' Gate - at top of orchard for equipment access. 4' Gate at orchard base for visitor access.

20 foot "tractor swing room" between fence and planted rows of trees on interior perimeter

Min 6' exterior perimeter between fence and field growth to allow mowing and access

13 rows of trees 15' apart
38 trees in each row
planted at 7' spacing
with total capacity 494 trees

Row alignment in both axis to allow mowing both directions

Orchard fence 220 feet wide by 300 feet long. Fence length total of 1040 feet.

Total enclosed area 60,000 approximately 1.6 acres

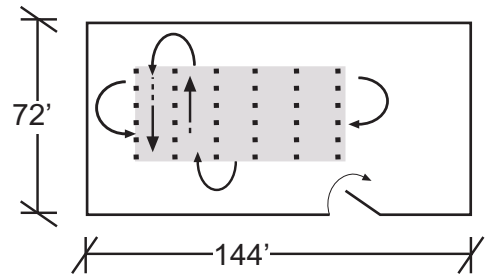
Fence spec - galvanized lock link 8 foot high. Rot resistant posts designed for 20 year life.

6 rows of trees 15' apart 6 trees in each row
planted 7' spacing - total capacity 36 trees

Orchard fence 72 feet wide by 144 feet long.
Fence length total of 432 feet.

Total enclosed area 10,400 ft sq. (~ 1/4 acre)
